Legacy Week

Memorial Service – 7 September 2018

A Memorial Service is being organised for 9.00am on Friday 7th September 2018 to honour the thirteen RAAF personnel who lost their lives when 11 Squadron PBY-5 Catalina A24-52 crashed on landing on Cleveland Bay on 7th September 1943. This date is the 75th Anniversary of this accident is is a very significant date in the history of Townsville during World War 2.

The Service will be held at the existing Memorial that is in place near the Rockpool on The Strand.

We have received great support from The Senior Australian Defence Force Officer, Wing Commander Phil Godfrey who will be supplying the Base Chaplain to conduct the service and a Catafalque Party along with some uniformed personnel. There is a very good possibility that 11 Squadron will also provide a PA-8 Posiedon Maritime Patrol Aircraft for a flypast during the event. The PA-8 is the aircraft that is replacing the P3-C Orion Maritime Patrol Aircraft in the RAAF.

All members and families are invited to attend.
